ROBOROUGH ROTARY

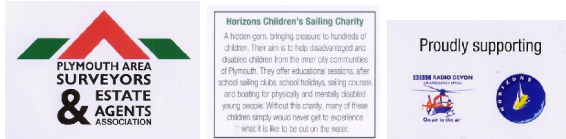

Once a year Mayflower Marina hosts the World Cruising Club and Horizons provides a minibus to take the competitors to Sainsbury's in the city centre to stock up

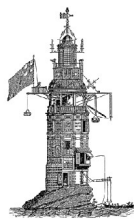


before leaving. We run a shopping shuttle run on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, with an evening bus for their party at Albion Rugby Club on the Friday.
