
PPSA REGATTA

Unfortunately it was a repeat of last year and there was only a very small amount of wind. This meant for the second year running, we didn't go out to the lighthouse, but to the University's Weather Buoy instead. This roughly shortened the course by half.



At 09:30 our Hawks started their pursuit. All 4 got a great start with the wind blowing steady until we got to the breakwater. After the breakwater however, the wind died off and the tide was at its strongest so the battle to the mark began. 'Fluency' and 'La Faucon' stayed West and hugged the Cornwall coast whereas 'Miss Muffet' and 'Papagena' stayed in the middle. Due to the incoming tide, hugging the west coast turned out to



be the quickest route as Miss Muffet and Papagena got forcefully pushed east.

After a long, tiring and hot 10 hours on the water, 5pm passed and all Horizons boats had ran out of time and had to retire. This involved messaging Eddystone Control with their position, starting their engines and heading for home. Thankfully all our
